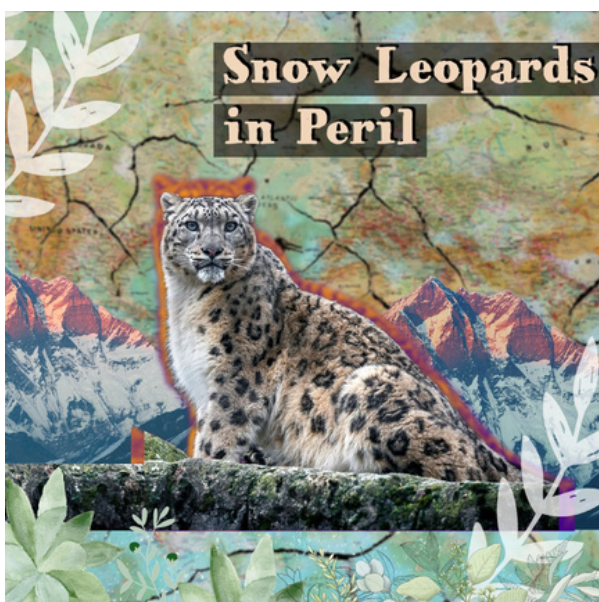

KAZIRANGA NATIONAL PARK

OUTSTANDING CONSERVATION VALUES

- LARGEST UNDISTURBED AND REPRESENTATIVE AREA UNDER THE BRUNAPUTRA VALLEY FLOOD PLAINS
- WORLD'S LARGEST POPULATION OF:
 - The Great Indian One Horned Rhinoceros (*Rhinoceros unicornis*) 250000
 - The Asiatic Wild Buffalo (*Bubalus bubalis*) 400000
 - The Eastern Race of the Swamp Deer (*Cervus swampii*) 450000
- SIGNIFICANT POPULATION OF ASIAN ELEPHANT (*Elephas maximus*) 450000
- ONE OF THE HIGHEST DENSITIES OF TREES (*Shorea robusta*) 100000
- RICH IN BIRD DIVERSITY 400 SPECIES RECORDED INCLUDES 25 GLOBALLY THREATENED AND 21 NEAR THREATENED SPECIES.
- A PROTECTED ELEPHANT AND IBA (IMPORTANT BIRD AREA) SITE.

PRIMARY SPECIES

It is home to endangered species like:

- Bengal tiger
- One-horn rhinoceros
- Elephant
- Pygmy hog

BEST TIME TO VISIT

The best time to visit Kaziranga National Park is from November to April, but the park is closed during the monsoon season.

NEAREST AIRPORT

Jorhat Airport, 96 kilometers from Kaziranga National Park, is the closest airport.
